

## **X. MINERAL RESOURCES -- Would the project:**

- a) Result in the loss of availability of a known mineral resource that would be of value to the region and the residents of the state?

Finding: No impact

According to the Los Angeles Citywide General Plan Framework, the project site is not located in an area containing significant mineral deposits.<sup>31</sup> Furthermore, the project site is not located within in an area of current or historical aggregate mining and is not within the limits of an active or historic oil field.<sup>32</sup> Therefore, the project will not result in a significant impact to the availability of known mineral resources.

- b) Result in the loss of availability of a locally-important mineral resource recovery site delineated on a local general plan, specific plan or other land use plan?

Finding: No impact

The project site is located within the Reseda - West Van Nuys Community Plan. No mineral resource recovery is identified in this Plan. Furthermore, the Los Angeles Citywide General Plan Framework does not identify the project site or project area as having locally-important mineral resources. Therefore, the project will not result in a significant impact to the availability of a locally-important mineral resource.
