Single Use Operating Permit Instructions

Air Carriers requesting to conduct business at Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) on an on-demand, non-permanent basis, including one-time operations, are required to obtain a Single Use Operating Permit (SUOP).

A new Single Use Operating Permit is required for each request to utilize LAX. A Single Use Operating Permit may be issued to an Air Carrier no more than <u>five</u> times in a calendar year. Upon request for a second Single Use Operating Certificate, said Air Carrier shall commence with the procedure to obtain a Non-Exclusive Air Carrier Operating Permit which must be fully executed prior to said Air Carrier's sixth facility use.* Prolonged use of Single Use Permits may incur Custom fees.

- 2) Evidence of Insurance Form (page 2) See Items 1 and 2 of Evidence of Insurance Form (attached). Also please attach a copy of your insurance certificate.
- 3) Affidavit of Compliance Form (page 3)

Air Carrier must provide a signed original of the Affidavit of Compliance (attached).

4) Air Carrier Certificate

Air Carriers must provide a copy of their Air Carrier Certificate issued by the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration.

5) Landing Fee and Parking Fee

The landing fee and parking fee must be paid in advance by credit card, wire transfer or ACH payment before permit can be approved. Fees will be calculated once request is submitted to our office.

6) Air Traffic Report

The attached report must be received within ten (10) days following the end of the calendar month of operation. Mailing instructions are listed on the report.

*Note: All air carriers, including single use carriers, at LAX are required to operate Stage 3 aircraft per Ordinance 168852 (LAX). The issuance of any Single Use Operating Certificate shall be at the Department's discretion based on factors that include but are not limited to, the Air Carrier's past compliance with Department Rules and Regulations.
