



SEPULVEDA TUNNEL UPGRADE PROJECT

Bureau of Street Lighting at the City of Los Angeles Public Works has initiated a project to upgrade the Sepulveda Tunnel to retrofit current lighting with new and improved LED lights and conduits. In addition, the scope of the project extends to pressure washing and repainting the tunnel walls. The duration of the project is scheduled for 180 days but in consideration of anticipated traffic increase during the holiday period, work will be suspended during this period.

Following are the details of work hours and duration:

- Duration of the project: 180 days
October 2012 through June 2013.
- Start date: Tuesday, October 2nd, 2012
- Work hours: 2200 – 0500hrs (Monday through Friday)
2200 – 0800hrs (Saturday and Sunday)
- Lane Closures: Two lanes closest to the median
- Lanes Open: At least one lane in both north and south bound directions during working hours.
- Work restriction dates: October 11th and 12th, 2012
Space Shuttle Endeavor movement
- November 16th through January 2nd
Holiday moratorium: Thanksgiving and Christmas.

Traffic mitigation plans have been developed and will be implemented during periods of heavy traffic. Contract work is also expected to implement proper remediation for use of water and care in the use of exhaust fan systems in the tunnel.
