New Height Restrictions for Vehicles on the Air Operations Area (AOA)

In an effort to enhance safety on the AOA, all operators of vehicles and equipment over 14 feet in height must obtain approval from LAWA (424) 646-5292 prior to accessing the vehicle service roads on the AOA. Operators of vehicles and equipment over 14 feet in height must also obtain approval from LAWA prior to entering any AOA Security Access Posts.

Airport Operations will be affixing placards to vehicles and equipment that are over 14 feet in height, advising the operators of this requirement. Warning signs will be installed at the AOA Security Access Posts and at various locations on the AOA as a reminder to vehicle service road users. Additionally, Section 4 (Motor Vehicle Operations) of the LAWA Rules and Regulations has been revised to include the following restriction:

(i). All vehicles and equipment over 14 feet in height must obtain approval from LAWA (424) 646-5292 prior to accessing the AOA Vehicle Service Roads. NOTE: This requirement does not apply to vehicles operating on Vehicle Service Road A.
