Taxiway Renaming Project – Taxiway R and Taxilane R1 Change to Taxiway N and Taxilane N1 Effective September 10, 2020

Phase 9 of the LAX Taxiway Renaming Project will be complete and effective Thursday, September 10, 2020. Phase 9 includes the changes indicated below. Please see page 2 updated LAX Airport Diagram depicting the changes.

Taxiway Name Changes:

- Taxiway R will change to Taxiway N.
- Taxilane R1 will change to Taxilane N1.
- Taxiway N2 will be published on aeronautical charts, but will not open until this
 phase of construction is complete for the MSC and Taxiway P Projects.
- Taxilane M will be published on aeronautical charts, but will not open until this phase of construction is complete for the MSC Project.

Taxiway N2 between Taxiway N and Taxilane M and Taxilane M south of Taxiway D are currently under construction and will not open until Fall 2020 as part of the MSC Project. Taxiway N2 between Taxiway N and the future Taxiway P is currently under construction and will not open until first quarter 2021 as part of the Taxiway P Project. NOTAMs will be published showing these taxiway segments as closed until they are opened for aircraft movement.
