About LAMP

The Landside Access Modernization Program (LAMP) consists of a series of projects to improve the LAX passenger experience, relieve congestion, and enhance LAX's status as a world-class airport. These improvements include:

- An elevated, 2.25-mile Automated People Mover System
- Two Intermodal Transportation Facilities with parking areas allowing for drop-offs and pick-ups from vehicles, buses, shuttles, taxis and ride-sharing services
- A Consolidated Rental Car Facility which will combine the rental car agencies into one location
- > A comprehensive series of roadway improvements to alleviate traffic congestion in and around airport facilities
- Connecting LAX with Metro's proposed Airport Metro Connector Station, to be located at 96th Street/Aviation Boulevard
