

QATAR AIRWAYS RELOCATES TO NEW TOM BRADLEY INTERNATIONAL TERMINAL AT LOS ANGELES INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (LAX)

The state-of-the-art terminal grants Qatar Airways passengers access to free Wi-Fi, new lounge space, and more than 60 restaurants and upscale shops.

DOHA, Qatar – Qatar Airways, the multiple award-winning airline with connectivity to more than 150 global business and leisure destinations, announces its relocation to Tom Bradley International Terminal (TBIT) from Terminal 2 at Los Angeles International Airport, effective May 1, 2017.

“The relocation to Tom Bradley International Terminal is proof of our commitment to creating a more enjoyable and efficient experience for our passengers. We are dedicated to ensuring all our passengers experience the best of Los Angeles International Airport, and the new terminal location reflects the luxury and quality service for which Qatar Airways is known,” said Gunter Saurwein, Qatar Airways Vice President – Americas.

Reopened in 2013, the refurbished Tom Bradley International Terminal features a sleek, modern atmosphere. With LED screens and a new Great Hall, the Antonio Villaraigosa Pavilion, TBIT boasts the finest dining, shopping and relaxation offerings; including Fred Segal, Coach, Umami Burger, 800 Degrees, and more. The new terminal also has free Wi-Fi and 18 new boarding gates.

Qatar Airways Business Class passengers will have access to the exclusive **oneworld** lounge, operated by fellow alliance member Qantas. As a member of the **oneworld** alliance, Qatar Airways passengers are eligible to earn and redeem Qatar Airways Privilege Club Miles across the member airlines and they enjoy status recognition around the **oneworld** system.

Further, Terminals 4, 5, 6 and 7, as well as Tom Bradley International Terminal, are all connected behind TSA screening, creating a seamless process for passengers to walk among these terminals without the need to exit and re-clear security.

Launched on New Year's Day in 2016 (January 1), the Los Angeles route features the airline's landmark Boeing 777-200 and represents Qatar Airways' first passenger service to the West Coast of the United States. Qatar Airways currently operates one daily nonstop flight from Los Angeles to Doha:

Qatar Airways currently has ten U.S. gateways, Los Angeles being the airline's 8th U.S. destination. This route is one of the airline's newest gateways launched in the past year, alongside the Boston and Atlanta routes that launched in March 2016 and June 2016, respectively. Qatar Airways will also commence service to Las Vegas in 2018. In addition to new routes, the airline recently launched its new Qsuite for Business Class, the industry's first-ever double bed available in Business Class, with privacy panels that stow away, allowing passengers in adjoining seats to create their own private room.
