INTRODUCTION AND ADOPTION OF OCTOBER 24, 2007 MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 5:07 p.m. and roll was taken. The committee approved the October 24, 2007 minutes.

AIRPORT COMMENTS

Pete Morejon reported 37,297 aircraft operations for the 4TH quarter, Oct.- Dec. 2007. In addition, there were 9 noise complaints. An update will be given on the 1st quarter Jan.- Mar. 2008, operations and noise reports at the next meeting.

CITY OF ONTARIO

No representative present.

NEW BUSINESS

Mr. Morejon announced that Airline Representative, Andrew Cookson, of Delta Airlines has relocated and will no longer be a part of the committee.

Mr. Morejon also advised the committee that an application for a new Variance is being submitted with the State of California, Department of Transportation.

Mario Alonzo, of the LAX Noise Management Division, was introduced by Mr. Morejon as a representative who would be addressing the committee on the status of ONT/LA noise monitors.

Mr. Alonzo informed the committee on the locations of the 16 monitors which are installed around Ontario International Airport. Of these 16 monitors 8 have been completely refurbished. Currently, there are another 8 monitors in the process of being built. 3 monitors will be completed by the end of January and the remaining 5 will be completed by the end of February. The new monitors are not only more accurate in picking up data, they are also environmentally friendly. They operate from their solar panel rather than power.

Mr. Alonzo further advised the committee that improvements are currently being made to the Los Angeles World Airport's Internet site (<http://www.lawa.org>), under the ONT Noise Management section.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

An informal discussion took place during the meeting with the general public. Randy Cavion and Nadine E. Hutchinson inquired about the increase in noise and aircraft activity, and the disposition of the Lockheed Facility.
