INTRODUCTION AND ADOPTION OF JANUARY 9, 2008 MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 5:10 p.m. and roll was taken. The committee approved the January 9, 2008 minutes.

AIRPORT COMMENTS

Pete Morejon reported 34,754 aircraft operations for the 1st quarter, Jan. - Mar. 2008. In addition, there were 8 noise complaints. An update will be given on the 2nd quarter Apr. - Jun. 2008 operations and noise reports at the next meeting.

CITY OF ONTARIO

Mr. Rivera reported 2 Sound Insulation projects for a total of 116 houses are under construction; completion is expected June 2008. Another project consisting of approximately 75 houses is being initiated; bidding will go out for this project in June 2008, and construction will begin in the Fall. Mr. Rivera further added that by the end of this year or the beginning of 2009, the City of Ontario will be reaching its 1000th house through the Sound Insulation Program. Mr. Rivera also advised the committee that the City of Ontario was in the process of applying for \$3.75 million grant to the FAA and LAWA for another Sound Insulation Project to begin next year.

Mr. Rivera advised the committee that 20 homes are being purchased through the Property Acquisition Program which was funded by FAA and LAWA. Another application is being processed for submission to FAA and LAWA for another \$11.25 million for additional land acquisition.

Mr. Rivera would like to thank FAA and LAWA for their support of the Sound Insulation and Land Acquisition Programs.

NEW BUSINESS

Mr. Morejon announced that Betsy Eskridge, California Department of Transportation, will be attending the next meeting to be held July 9, 2008 to discuss the draft version of the Noise Variance.

Mr. Morejon advised that a new committee member; Deanna Uhler, of ExpressJet has volunteered to become the Airline Representative for the Ontario Airport Noise Advisory Committee.

Mr. Morejon informed the committee that The City of Los Angeles has retained KH Consulting Group to conduct a comprehensive review of the operation, management, and administration of LAWA, including Ontario. A meeting, open to the public, is scheduled for Wednesday, April 16, 2008 7pm-9pm.

Mario Alonzo, of the LAX Noise Management Division, gave an update on the Noise Monitoring Systems.

Mr. Alonzo informed the committee on the locations of the monitors which are installed around Ontario International Airport. The new monitors are not only more accurate in picking up data, they are also environmentally friendly. They operate from their solar panel rather than power.
