**INTRODUCTION AND ADOPTION OF APRIL 2, 2008 MINUTES**

The meeting was called to order at 5:19 p.m. and roll was taken. The committee approved the April 2, 2008 minutes.

**AIRPORT COMMENTS**

Pete Morejon reported 33,093 aircraft operations for the 2nd quarter, Apr. - June 2008. In addition, there were 7 noise complaints. An update will be given on the 3rd quarter July - Sept. 2008 operations and noise reports at the next meeting.

**CITY OF ONTARIO**

Mr. Sigfrido Rivera reported Phase 6 of the Sound Insulation Project had been completed. With the completion of this phase, the total number of houses insulated to date is 973. A new grant has been awarded by FAA for 3 million dollars for Noise Sound Proofing efforts. The City of Ontario is working with LAWA to secure the matching funds for the grant. Mr. Rivera states that once the program is implemented approximately 75 additional homes will be soundproofed. Mr. Rivera also advised the committee that the City of Ontario is currently working on the bid documents to award a new contract for Phase 7 of the Sound Insulation Project, which will include 75 and 100 houses. A grant application has also been submitted to LAWA for \$11.25 million dollars, which will purchase an additional 22 properties, to continue land acquisition efforts near the airport. To date, 215 properties have been acquired.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Kathy McKinley introduced Dr. Jim Kidwell as her possible replacement for the Ontario/Montclair School District Representative. Ms. McKinley expects the Ontario/Montclair School District to be forthcoming with their selection by the next OANAC meeting.

Mr. Morejon advised the committee that on September 2, 2008 ExpressJet will cease a large part of their branded service. A portion of their service will remain for charter operations and maintenance service. Due to this change the committee will need to fill the position for another Airline Representative for the OANAC.

Betsy Eskridge, California Department of Transportation-Division of Aeronautics, discussed the draft version of the Noise Variance. Ms. Eskridge presented a PowerPoint presentation which gave the history of the noise standards and discussed what modifications could be made.

Mr. Morejon will be addressing the committee regarding modifications to the existing Variance at the next OANAC meeting.
