INTRODUCTION AND ADOPTION OF OCTOBER 6, 2009 MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 5:05 p.m. and roll was taken. The committee approved the October 6, 2009 minutes.

AIRPORT COMMENTS

Pete Morejon gave an update for aircraft operations for the 4th quarter 2009. There were 8,672 aircraft operations for October 2009 and 9 noise complaints; 8,074 aircraft operations for November 2009 and 5 noise complaints; 8,366 aircraft operations for December 2009 and 3 noise complaints. An update will be given on the 1st quarter 2010 operations and noise reports at the next meeting. In total LA/Ontario International Airport completed the year 2009 at a negative 13.2% in comparison to 2008.

CITY OF ONTARIO

Mr. Rivera informed the committee that another Noise Compatibility Program soundproofing project has been completed which included 77 houses. Another design phase is being initiated for sound proofing another 75 homes with opening bids to begin in the spring or summer of this year. Under the Property Acquisition Relocation Program, the Board of Airport Commissioners has authorized \$750,000.00 to purchase 12 additional properties near the airport. Mr. Sigfrido also informed the committee that the City of Ontario is currently working with the FAA for additional funding for both the soundproofing and property acquisition programs.

NEW BUSINESS

Mario Alonzo of the LAX Noise Management Division gave an update on the noise monitoring system. Mr. Alonzo informed the committee that per Cal-Trans, there were discrepancies found in the testing of the Airport Noise & Operations Monitoring System (ANOMS). These discrepancies were due to paperwork issues. Per Mr. Alonzo, adjustments have been made and further testing is underway. Approval from Cal-Trans is still forthcoming for LAX, VNY, and ONT. The 4th quarter noise contour for 2008 has been completed. Compared to the 2007 noise contour report the area has been significantly reduced by approx. 30%.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

The next OANAC Meeting was scheduled for Wednesday, April 7, 2010. The meeting was adjourned at 5:35p.m.
