



Employee Rideshare Program

Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) is proud of its award-winning Rideshare Program that is a benefit to our employees, the community, and the environment. The program's many options – including vanpools, carpools, and public transportation – help reduce congestion and pollution throughout the Southland. LAWA's program also supports the South Coast Air Quality Management District's (SCAQMD) air quality mitigation goals, while providing employees with the many personal benefits of ridesharing, including saving time and money.

In 2015, the program had an employee participation rate of 23 percent, saving more than 300,000 gallons of fuel.

Multifaceted Program

Its multifaceted Rideshare Program includes subsidized vanpools, carpools, public-transits incentives and bicycling, as well as marketing and advocacy activities to recruit and retain the participants.

LAWA also distributes monthly transit passes at no cost to employees who commute to work by bus or rail. Its employees are also encouraged to work a "9/80" or other non-traditional work schedule, which reduces commuter miles and congestion.

In addition, many of LAWA's employees and airport tenants bike to work. In order to further increase and encourage bicycling, LAWA has expanded its bicycle storage facilities at its airports, including on-site lockers and showers.

Huge Savings

The Rideshare Program saves up to 1,400 vehicle trips per day and 7 million commuter miles annually. It also eliminates almost 7.9 billion pounds of air pollutants every year, thousands of dollars in insurance and vehicle depreciation costs, and countless hours spent on Southern California's streets and freeways.

LAWA is continually being recognized for its Rideshare Program achievements. It has been honored with a Gold Medal in the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's "Best Workplace for Commuters Race to Excellence" and received a national award from the Association for Commuter Transportation for "Outstanding Service in the Public Sector." LAX is the only airport in the country to have received either of these awards.

Moreover, it has received 16 prestigious Rideshare Diamond Awards in 15 years for having one of the best employee transportation programs in Southern California. The awards were presented by a coalition of leading Southern California rideshare organizations.
