

**City of Los Angeles Department of Airports
Motor Vehicle Operating Permit for Los Angeles International Airport**

(ANNUAL)

This City of Los Angeles Department of Airports Motor Vehicle Operating Permit for Los Angeles International Airport (the "**Permit**") is subject to the Non-Exclusive License Agreement between the City of Los Angeles ("**City**"), a municipal corporation, acting by order of and through its Board of Airport Commissioners ("**Board**") and **Company Name** ("**Permittee**") commencing on **Date** (the "**Main Agreement**"). To the extent there are any conflicts between the provisions of this Permit and the Main Agreement, the provisions of the Main Agreement shall be controlling.

A. Term of Permit: The term of this Permit shall commence on **Date**, and terminate on **Date**, but in no event shall this Permit extend beyond the term of the Main Agreement. This Permit, or any extension thereof, shall be subject to termination upon thirty (30) days' advance written notice by either party.

B. Permit Fee: Permittee shall pay an annual administrative fee of One Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$120) for each vehicle. Such fee shall be paid in advance of the issuance of a vehicle access decal. The Board reserves the right, power and duty to fix, determine, revise and readjust the rates and fees assigned for the operations of motor vehicles in common use areas of Airport.

C. Operating Rights: With this Permit, City authorizes Permittee to operate its motor vehicle(s) at Airport and to have the right of access to public roadways and to the following non-public areas at Airport: all posts to conduct motor vehicle operations in conjunction with fuel deliveries at the Airport. Permittee acknowledges and agrees that the obligations herein are in addition to the obligations set forth in the Main Agreement.

D. Vehicle Access Decal: A vehicle access decal shall be issued. Such decal is non-transferable and must be prominently displayed on the front inside, lower left windshield of the driver's side of the vehicle. Transfer, duplication, alteration, or use by any unauthorized party or other misuse of the vehicle access decal may result in the termination of this Permit and access and driving privileges on the AOA. If a vehicle access decal is lost, stolen or damaged, Permittee must immediately notify Airport Police at (424) 646-5690 and Airfield Permits at (424) 646-5880.

E. Vehicle Information: Permittee shall complete the vehicle information required in Exhibit A attached hereto for all vehicles being registered under this Permit.

F. Rules and Regulations: Permittee and each of Permittee's drivers shall abide by all (i) policies adopted by the Board, and (ii) the rules and regulations of Los Angeles World Airports, including the Rules and Regulations of Los Angeles International Airport, (available at <https://www.lawa.org/airops/rules.cfm>). Each of Permittee's drivers shall have successfully completed the security badging requirements and the "Restricted Area Driver's Examination" prior to being issued a security badge. The Executive Director may, at any time, without refund of fees to Permittee, revoke any Permit or vehicle access decal for failure on the part of the Permittee or Permittee's driver(s) to abide by any and all conditions stated in the Permit, the Main Agreement or the violation of any rules of Los Angeles Department of Airports ("**LAWA**") or orders of LAWA's Executive Director or his or her authorized representatives.

G. Assignment: Licensee shall not, in any manner, assign, transfer or encumber this Permit, or any portion thereof or any interest therein, nor shall Permittee license or otherwise authorize the use of, in whole or in part, the rights granted by this Permit.
