ACDBE Program Purpose

- To "give business opportunities to certain small business concerns that operate at airports and, that are owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals"
- To "help them...become self-sufficient, and able to compete with non-disadvantaged firms"

- 1. A: General
- 2. B: Administrative
- 3. C: Certification
- 4. D: Goals
- 5. E: Other Provisions

Subpart A: General

- Ensure non-discrimination
- •Create a level playing field.
- Ensure 'real' ACDBEs participation
- Remove barriers to participation.

ACDBE Definition

- for-profit small business
- at least 51 percent owned

- socially and economically disadvantaged or,
- •51% of stock ownership.

ACDBE Definition – continued

Management and daily business operations.

Concession Definition

Means one of more of the types of forprofit businesses listed below:

 A business, located on an airport, that is engaged in the sale of consumer goods or services to the public under an agreement with the recipient, another concessionaire, or the owner or lessee of a terminal, if other than the recipient.

Concession Definition - continued

2. A business conducting one or more of the following covered activities, even if it does not maintain an office, store, or other business location on an airport subject to this part, as long as the activities take place on the airport.

Types of Concession Agreements

- •Leases
- Subleases
- Contract and Subcontracts

Two-Step Process:

- Step 1. Determine the Base Figure for the relative availability of ACDBE firms.
- Step 2. Determine if any adjustments are needed to arrive at the overall ACDBE goal.

Determining Base Figure – cont.

ACDBE Directories and Census Bureau Data

Determine the number of ready, willing and able ACDBEs in the market area from the ACDBE directory.

-Total Number of ACDBE-certified Firms: 43

-Total Number of Firms in the respective NAICS codes: 8,081

43 / 8,081 = <u>0.53% Base Figure</u>

Adjustments

- Averaged the Base Figure (0.53%) with the median ACDBE achievement (1.9%) resulting in an Adjusted Base Figure of 1.2%.
- Averaged the Adjusted Base Figure (1.2%) with the FFY 2023 achievement (1.9%) resulting in 1.6%



Goal Setting Methodology for Non-Car Rental

Two-Step Process:

Step 1. Determine the Base Figure for the relative availability of ACDBE firms.

Step 2. Determine if adjustments are needed to arrive at the overall ACDBE goal.

Determining Base Figure

LAWA Active Participants List

Determine the number of ACDBEs based on participation in LAWA concession opportunities at LAX for the past three FFYs:

Total Number of ACDBE Firms (LAX):	71
Total Number of Active Firms:	348

71 / 348 = 20.4% - Base Figure

Adjustments

- Averaged the Base Figure (20.4%) with the median ACDBE achievement (25.9%) resulting in an Adjusted Base Figure of 23.2%.
- Averaged the Adjusted Base Figure (23.2%) with the FFY 2023 achievement (26.3%) resulting in 24.8%
