## **Regulations - Policies - Agreements**

- Federal Aviation Regulation, Part 150, Airport Noise Compatibility Planning
- California Code of Regulations, Title 21, Subchapter 6, Airport Noise Standards
- California Code of Regulations, Title 24, Building Standards
- BOAC Resolution establishing the Land Use Mitigation Program, Supplemental Funding Program (Resolution No. 21481)
- LAX MP Stipulated Settlement Agreement
- Community Benefits Agreement



## LAWA Land Use Mitigation Programs (LUMP)

#### Established by BOAC Resolution No. 15844

- Board approved the Land Use Mitigation Program (LUMP)
   Supplemental Funding Policy (SFP) on May 20, 1987
- Several updates to this resolution and SFP last amended by Resolution No. 21481 in 2001
- Provide funding mechanism for noise-impacted jurisdictions and established guidelines for issuance of LAWA funds
  - City of El Segundo
  - City of Inglewood
  - City of Los Angeles
  - County of Los Angeles



## **Agreements Affecting LUMP**

#### Master Plan Stipulated Settlement Agreement

- Expedited funding for noise mitigation programs in the Cities of Inglewood and El Segundo, and the County of Los Angeles
  - Annual Funding Cap thru 2015 at \$22.5M
    - City of Inglewood
    - City of El Segundo
    - County of Los Angeles
- Suspension of Avigation Easements
- End-of-the-Block Soundproofing



## **Agreements Affecting LUMP**

#### Community Benefits Agreement (CBA)

- Established funding minimums for City of Inglewood and Los Angeles County
  - 4.275M Annually for each
- Settlement Agreements with Inglewood Unified and Lennox School Districts (subject to FAA determination regarding the use of airport funds)
  - Inglewood Unified School District
    - 10 Schools
    - Up to \$118,500,000
  - Lennox School District
    - 13 Schools
    - Up to \$111,000,000



## Mitigation Strategies

#### Soundproofing

- installing acoustically rated noise-reducing products
  - Windows and doors (including hardware and weather-stripping)
- Adding insulation in attics, and installing baffles at attic vents
- Installing Glass Fireplace Doors and Chimney Top Dampers
- Installing new HVAC systems or improving existing systems

#### Property Acquisition or Land Recycling

- Purchase of incompatible residential properties
- Re-zone properties for Commercial/Industrial or other Airportcompatible Use

  - Residential Acquisition (1998)
    - Manchester Square/Airport Belford
- City of Inglewood
  - Sound Insulation (1992)

- County of Los Angeles
  - Sound Insulation (1992)

#### **Schools**

- Lennox School District
  - Classroom SI (2011)
- Inglewood Unified School District
  - Classroom SI (2012)




## **LUMP Program Funding**

  - LAWA Funding
    - Passenger Facility Charges

## **Recent / Upcoming LAWA BOAC Actions**

- August 2011: BOAC approved funding for City of El Segundo Sound Insulation Program in the amount of \$5,587,500 to insulate 406 dwelling units. A portion of these funds are to match three FAA grants totaling \$12,790,345. Funding will come from LAWA revenue.
- September 2011: BOAC is set to approve the first phase of the Lennox Schools Program in the amount of \$10 million, per the requirements of the Settlement Agreement with the Lennox School District.
- October/November 2011: LA County Grant
- 4th Quarter 2011: IUSD PFC Application to FAA
