### Aircraft Sound Insulation Programs at LAX

- → Land uses around airports such as residences, schools, hospitals and places of worship, with a Community Noise Equivalent Level (CNEL) of 65 dB, are generally considered "incompatible" with the airport
- → Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) has an FAA-approved Noise Compatibility Program, which makes certain residential areas eligible for FAA funding
- → Federal (ANSA, 1979), State (Title 21, 1970) and Local (Reso 21481, 2001) rules provide eligibility and funding structure.

### **Program Governance and Funding**

### Stipulated Settlement Agreement (2006-2015)

- Provides up to \$240M in noise mitigation funding for Cities of El Segundo, Inglewood, County of LA
  - Initial disbursement for 2006 and 2007 of \$60M
  - → "Future Funding" for 2008 2015 has annual cap of \$22.5M shared by 3 jurisdictions; maximum of \$180M over 8 year period

### Community Benefits Agreement (2005-2020)

- Minimum Funding for County of LA and City of Inglewood (\$4.275M for each)
- → Other Benefits end-of-block soundproofing, suspension/purchase of avigation easements (≥ 75 dBL)

## LAWA's Sound Insulation Grant Program 2015 Highlights

- Funding of \$80 Million Dollars provided over six months to jurisdictions between August 2014 and January 2015
- Sound Insulation Construction in progress for over 2,600 dwelling units in Inglewood, Lennox, Athens, Del Aire and El Segundo
- Oct 1, 2015 New FAA Rules for Two-Step Testing (PGL 12-09)
  - → Home inside 65 dB Contour and interior noise level of 45 dB or greater
  - Release of LAWA's Acoustical Testing Program (Draft Feb 2015, Final June 2015)
  - Provision/Amendment for Acoustical Testing Funds
- → 2015/2016 New Noise Exposure Maps for LAX and ONT Rolls Out
- Funding begins for Inglewood Unified School District's Sound Insulation Program

### **How Noise is Mitigated**

### **Typical Sound Insulation Techniques:**

#### Residential:

- Replacing windows, and doors (including hardware and weatherstripping)
- → Adding insulation in attics, and installing baffles at attic vents
- Installing glass fireplace doors, and chimney top dampers

#### **Schools:**

- Replacement of doors and new threshold for the exterior classroom doors
- Install new windows where wood replacement or dry wall-blocked windows currently exist
- Exterior wall insulation and interior sound panels as needed

#### **Both:**

- Mechanical system upgrades (HVAC/PVS) with sound traps and vibration control as needed
- → Target of 45 dB interior noise level, and/or a 5 dB reduction








- → FAA is in receipt of extension request thru December 2015 from the County.

- → Per Settlement: 11 Schools and up to \$111 million
- → FAA approved a PFC application for 11 Schools, \$35 million
- → December 2011 \$10 Million; 1st Work Plan 5 Schools
- → June 2014: \$10 Million; 2<sup>nd</sup> Work Plan 4 schools
- → July 2015: Completed Schools = Huerta Elementary, Animo Leadership High School, Felton Elementary, Lennox Middle School, Jefferson ORG
  - In Progress: Jefferson Elementary, Buford, and Jefferson Pre-School
  - → Removed: New Media and Performing Arts H.S. State Law changed, Moffett and Lennox M&S deferred
