LAX Full Scale Exercise

Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) will be conducting a Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) mandated full-scale exercise on Wednesday, April 24, 2013 between 0900-1400 hours at the Flight Path Learning Center and Museum. During the exercise an increase in traffic along Imperial Highway is likely to occur. Special effects in the form of a small controlled pyrotechnic will be used around 1100 hours. In addition, Taxiway A and Service Road A will be closed between Taxiway A6 and Taxiway T to traffic for the duration of the event. Please plan for alternate routes during this period.

This drill emphasizes LAWA's continued commitment to an effective and well-coordinated response should an incident occur. Thank you for your understanding.
