Service Road S Opening

Prior to the September 18th opening of the remaining Bradley West gates, Service Road 'S' will be opened from Service Road 'C' to Service Road 'E' on September 16, 2013 at 0001L. This service road has been designated for vehicles associated with the Tom Bradley International Terminal (TBIT) operations. All other vehicles must use Service Road 'R' or Service 'AA' to transition between the north and south complexes.

It is anticipated that traffic on Service Road 'S' will be slow moving due to aircraft that will be required to cross the service road to access the TBIT West gates. Please use extreme caution when operating on Service Road 'S'. All vehicle operators must give way to aircraft powering in or pushing off the TBIT West gates and abide by the 10 MPH speed limit. Please see the attached map that depicts the new service road.
