



Relocation of Hainan Airlines from Terminal 2 to Tom Bradley International Terminal on April 7, 2017

Airport and airline staff will relocate 28 airlines as part of Delta Airlines' move from Terminals 5 and 6 to Terminals 2 and 3. The majority of the relocation will take place between May 12th and May 17th.

As part of the realignment, Hainan Airlines will relocate terminals in advance of the larger move. Hainan Airlines will move their operations from Terminal 2 to Tom Bradley International Terminal (TBIT) on Friday, April 14, 2017. Hainan passengers will check-in, be directed to security screening, and depart from TBIT Gates. Arriving passengers on Hainan flights will be processed and cleared through Federal Inspection Services at TBIT.

Roadway overhead signs will be updated to show Hainan Airlines departing from TBIT and overhead sign for Parking Structure 3 will also list Hainan Airlines. All airport employees, tenants, stakeholders, service providers, and ground transportation providers are advised to note the change and disseminate information to all concerned.
