## **Taxilane C9 Reconstruction Project**

Taxilane C9 north of Taxiway C between Terminals 4 and 5 will be closed for 30 days for reconstruction of the keel section starting on Tuesday, January 19, 2021 at 0001L through Thursday, February 18, 2021 at 0001L. The purpose of this work is to reconstruct the Taxilane C9 keel section with concrete, replacing the asphalt section that has been susceptible to rutting. All impacted airlines will be accommodated at other terminal gates and remote parking. Please see pages 2 and 3 for project plans.

## Operational Impacts:

- Gates on the west side of Terminal 4 will not be accessible to aircraft. This includes gates 40, 42A, 42B, 46A/B/C, and 48A.
- Gates on the east side of Terminal 5 will not be accessible to aircraft. This includes gates 51A, 51B, 53A, 53B, and 55A.
- Gate 57 will remain accessible to A321 and smaller (wingspan less than 118 ft.) with temporary modified lead in centerline markings. All aircraft accessing Gate 57 must be towed in.
- Taxiway C9 between Taxiway B and Taxiway C will be restricted to A321 and smaller (wingspan less than 118 ft.) during construction activities to reduce jet blast hazard to the work area.
- Vehicle traffic at the north end of Taxilane C9 will be restricted to one lane during the taxilane reconstruction. Appropriate signs will be placed to mitigate any hazard and maintain access for all vehicles and personnel.

Notices to Airmen (NOTAMs) will be issued 120 hours prior to the scheduled closure and restriction. Please plan flight operations accordingly.
