Airport security standards have changed since 9/11 to include increased law enforcement of 811 officers compared to 517 prior to 9/11; LAPD Bomb Squad unit on airport grounds 24/7; capital improvement projects, crimes dropped by 82 percent, and LAX's affiliation with two federal agencies: TSA and FAA.
