Preliminary wording from LAWA's Request for **Proposals:**

"Establish a partial curfew at Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) that would prohibit the easterly departure of all aircraft, with certain exemptions, between the hours of 12:00 midnight to 6:30 a.m. when the airport is in Over Ocean **Operations, or when it remains in Westerly Operations during these hours**"



What is LAWA's Proposed Noise Rule?





Part 161 of the Federal Aviation Regulations specifies procedures that must be followed by any airport intending to implement a proposed noise rule

Part 161 requirements include: • Cost and benefit analyses of the proposed rule Examination of alternatives Public notice and opportunity for comment by affected parties Establishment of a public docket

FAA Headquarters must approve the study before the proposed rule can be put into effect
