You may want to request a copy of the certification letter from the subcontractors to verify their ACDBE status. Further, you must ensure that the specific categories of work that the ACDBEs will perform on the project match the NAICS (North American Industry Classification System) codes for which they were certified in order for you to receive ACDBE participation credit from LAWA.
