Terminal 4 Restroom Closures: Right: Women's RR, Ticketing Below: Women's & Men's RR, Concourse




2. Terminal 5 Departures Level Barricade

3. Terminal 6: Arrivals / Departures Level Stairway Re-Opened


• The stairway outside Terminal 6 between the Arrivals and Departures levels has re-opened following the completion of painting and maintenance work.
