Construction Hot Topics

Week of March 23, 2020

1. Terminal B (Tom Bradley International): Airline Gate 134

- Airline Gate 134 is scheduled to close March 23 through November 12, 2020, to facilitate construction for the MSC North project
- Airline Gate 132, which has been closed since May 22, 2017 for the MSC North project, reopened on March 17, 2020

2. Terminal 7: Departures Level Barricades

- As part of the Terminal 7 Core & APM Interface Project, temporary stairs have started being built following the completion of the escalator demolition between the Ticketing and Gate levels
- Construction barricades are now being installed inside the terminal on the Departures Level to facilitate future work for this project; wayfinding signage will be in place to detour passengers

3. CTA Roadways: Departures Level Terminal 2 / 3:

- To facilitate construction for the Delta Sky Way Program, nightly work has begun to install a temporary pedestrian sidewalk, construction barricades and protective canopy on the Departures Level between Terminals 2 and 3
- During construction of the temporary sidewalk, both drop off lanes at this area will be restricted with passenger Drop-Off and Pick-Up prohibited; through traffic will be maintained
- The Hotel Shuttle Stop at Terminal 3 was relocated approximately 175 feet to the west to maintain access during this construction; it is scheduled to move back to its previous location in approximately five weeks
