

1. Terminal 2 / 3: Construction Update


- Foundation work and steel erection continues on the Terminal 2 / 3 future Head House as part of the Delta Sky Way program
- Upon completion, the Head House will facilitate ticketing, check-in and baggage claim for the two terminals and also connect to the pedestrian walkway bridge from the Automated People Mover's Center CTA Station

2. Terminal 4.5: Construction Update

- Construction continues on the Terminal 4.5 Terminal Cores and APM Interface project, with foundation work for the future elevator and escalator pits occurring airside while a temporary pedestrian walkway is built curbside on the Departures Level to detour passengers and around future construction
- Scheduled for completion in late 2022, the Terminal 4.5 building will feature check-in and security processing areas, and a pedestrian bridge that connects to the APM's West Station

3. Terminal 2: Airline Gate Changes

- Airline Gate 26A is scheduled to close Tuesday, September 1 through Thursday, October 15 while construction occurs airside
- Airline Gate 28, which closed late July 2020, is scheduled to re-open Thursday, September 3

Gate 26A closes this week for a month and a half, while Gate 28 reopens after a month of closures
