#### 1. Terminal 4.5: Construction Updates

- The Terminal 4.5 Core Project has completed the installation of the curtain wall (glass panel façade) on the future connector building between Terminals 4 and 5
- Once completed, the Terminal 4.5 Core will provide vertical transportation and enhanced connectivity for both Terminals 4 and 5, as well as to the APM's West CTA Station
- Inner roadway lanes are restricted on both levels to be used as temporary pedestrian walkways; traffic and passenger pick-up / drop-off is maintained at all times around these restrictions




Current progress on Terminal 4.5 (Curtain wall complete, APM pedestrian bridge under construction)

#### 2. Airport Police Facility: Project Update
