

1. Terminal 3 – B – 4: Arrivals Level Lane Restrictions

- SoCalGas is installing a gas line underneath the Arrivals Level roadway between Terminals 3, B
 and 4; to facilitate this work, portions of outer lanes may be restricted nightly through the end
 of the year
- Through traffic will be maintained at all times as well as access to and from Parking Structures 3 and 4 and pedestrian sidewalk / crosswalk access
- Note: This work will be performed in phases. The area illustrated below indicates entire project scope; work locations & restrictions will vary by night but traffic and access will be maintained



Terminals 3 - B - 4: Nightly Arrivals Level Lane Restrictions



2. Terminal 5.5: Departures Level Lane Restrictions

- To install glass panels on the façade of the building, the Terminal 5.5 Project will restrict some Departures Level roadway lanes between Terminals 5 and 6 nightly (10P to 6A) through October 22, 2021
- Vehicular traffic is maintained at all times
- Hotel & Private Parking Shuttle stops will be available both before and after the closure, along with passenger drop-off
- During work hours only, pedestrians must use the Arrivals Level sidewalk to travel between south side terminals and avoid the work zone; Flaggers and signage will be in place





Terminal 5.5: Nightly Departures Level Lane Restrictions





3. APM Guideway Construction

- The APM project is constructing a portion of guideway that will connect the existing guideway on either side of the Century Boulevard Flyover leading from northbound Sepulveda Boulevard to eastbound Century Boulevard
- A full closure will be in place tonight (8/31 from 12A to 4A) to facilitate this work; detours are in place
