1. LAX Economy Parking: Opens October 19

- The LAX Economy Parking Facility (Intermodal Transportation Facility-West / ITF-W) opens to the public on Tuesday, October 19
- The facility features approximately 4,300 new parking stalls equipped with smart parking technology like the ability to pre-book a stall, wayfinding, electric vehicle charging and more
- It is located at 6100 W 94th Street (off Westchester Parkway)

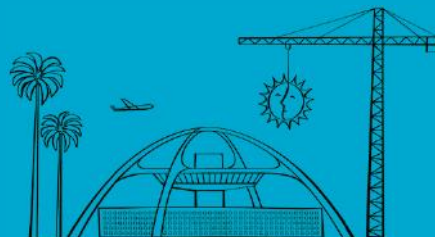
Until the Automated People Mover is operational, a dedicated shuttle bus will transport parkers between the facility and the CTA

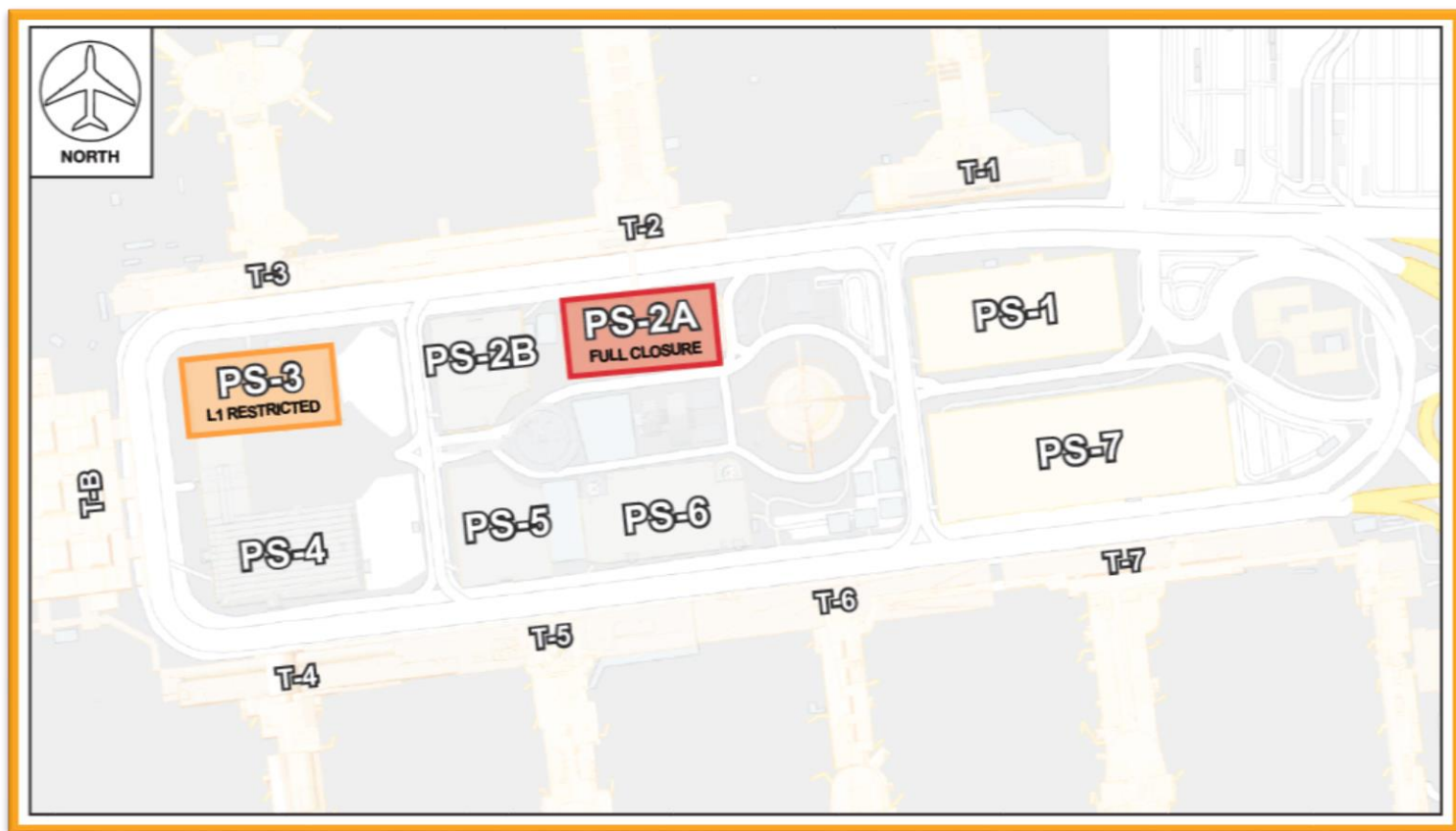

2. Parking Structure 2A & 3: Ongoing Construction Impacts

- As a reminder, work for the Smart Parking Project has PS-2A fully closed through November 2; vehicles may egress the structure if currently parked there
- Improvements include painting, installation of a Parking Guidance System, and other civil modifications
- Additionally, PS-3 Level 1 is also closed through November 2 to all vehicles except Taxis and CBP Vehicles; public passenger pickup, including charter vehicles, will not have access
- ABM Staff is on-site to assist with operations; Signage is in place to assist with alternative parking options, wayfinding and detours



PS-2A: Closed through 11/2
PS-3 L1: Restricted through 11/2
