

Week of February 14, 2022



- Phase 1 of American Airlines' Terminal 4 Modernization Program will begin this week, bringing major changes to the terminal's passenger flow and Ground Transportation stops
- Work is scheduled to begin Wednesday, February 16 and is ongoing through December 2025
- On the Arrivals Level, existing Shuttle Stops will be relocated per the map below; signage will be in place directing guests to relocated stops




Relocated Terminal 4 Arrivals Level Ground Transportation Stops as of 2/16/22

- 1. Terminal 4: Modernization Program (continued)
 - On the Departures Level, the South Knuckle (area between Terminal B & Terminal 4), which is currently a Hotel / Private Parking Stop. will change to a designated Passenger Drop Off zone
 - New Hotel / Private Parking Stops will be added at the North Knuckle (area between Terminal 3 & Terminal B) as well as at Terminal 4.5 (area between Terminal 4 & Terminal 5)
 - Signage will be in place directing guests to new and relocated stops

2. Terminal B: Construction Update

- Big changes are happening in Terminal B!
- New escalators have opened near the north end connecting guests between Level 1 (Arrivals / Bag Claim / Ground Transportation) and Level 3 (Departures / Ticketing / Hotel & Private Parking Shuttles)
- The Info Booth on the Departures Level has relocated near Aisle B
- Curbside, lane restrictions are now in place at the south end of the terminal, with the north end having been restored following the completion of certain phases of the project


Bottom left: The Departures Level Info Desk can now be found near Aisle B

Bottom right: Departures Level lanes at the "north knuckle" have re-opened, with new restrictions at the south end





3. Parking Structure 6: Pedestrian Detours

- On Wednesday, February 16, the Automated People Mover project will implement pedestrian detours at Parking Structure 6 while a new pedestrian ramp is constructed to provide access to the structure's elevator vestibule
- During this work (12AM to 8AM) a portion of the sidewalk and long crosswalk will be restricted, per the map below
- Additionally, one lane of traffic will be restricted alongside PS-6 continuously (24/7) through Saturday, April 16
