
Construction Hot Topics

Week of March 21, 2022

1. Terminal 5 / 6: Nightly Departures Level Impacts

- To facilitate enabling work for construction of the new Terminal 5.5 APM Pedestrian Bridge, the Hotel & Private Parking Shuttle Stop located between Terminals 5 & 6 (Departures Level) will be temporarily relocated nightly beginning Monday, March 21 through Saturday, May 28 from 12AM to 4AM
- The stop will be relocated to the east of the work area (near the west end of Terminal 6)
- Please note that due to heavy construction in the Central Terminal Area, some shuttle stop locations on both levels have recently shifted either temporarily or for the foreseeable future
- Please watch for posted signage and always use caution when traveling near construction areas

2. Terminal 5 / Parking Structure 5: Closure of Existing Pedestrian Bridge

- To facilitate improvements to Parking Structure 5, the existing Pedestrian Bridge connecting Terminal 5 and Parking Structure 5 over World Way South will be closed continuously beginning Wednesday, March 23 at 11PM through Wednesday, April 6 at 6AM (24/7 for two weeks)
- Pedestrians will need to use the Arrivals Level crosswalk across World Way South to travel between the Terminal and Parking Structure sides of the CTA at this area

3. Sepulveda Boulevard Tunnel Cleaning

- The Sepulveda Tunnel will experience nightly (11pm – 5am) lane restrictions next week for cleaning by the City of Los Angeles Bureau of Street Services
- Two lanes on either northbound or southbound Sepulveda Boulevard will be closed each night through Friday; one lane will be maintained at all times
