

1. Parking Structure 2A: Re-Opened

- Parking Structure 2A, which has been fully closed since late February 2022 for the ABM Smart
 Parking CTA Garage Improvements project, has re-opened as of Friday, March 25
- Improvements installed during this closure include upgraded gate arms, a Parking Guidance System (PGS), Electric Vehicle (EV) chargers, and more
- The Smart Parking project is ongoing throughout all parking structures in the CTA with varying impacts by structure; improvements are scheduled to be complete by this summer

Please note: The roof level of Parking Structure 2A remains closed to facilitate guideway work for the Automated People Mover project. The roof of PS-2A is currently scheduled to re-open in October 2022.

*Roof level remains closed through October 2022 for APM construction





3. Automated People Mover: Guideway Milestones


- The APM project recently completed its final concrete pour for the guideway segment spanning Parking Structure 2B
- Additionally, the project is scheduled to complete its final pour for the guideway segment spanning Sepulveda Boulevard later this week
- Following the completion of that pour, the APM's guideway will officially be fully connected from end to end, completing the 2.25 mile journey between the Consolidated Rent-A-Car facility (ConRAC) and the Central Terminal Area West Station near Tom Bradley International Terminal
