
1. Terminal 2 / 3 Central Headhouse Opening

- The new Terminal 2 / 3 centralized headhouse is scheduled to open to the public this week on Wednesday, April 20
- This new building will consolidate ticketing, check-in, security screening and baggage claim for passengers
- The new headhouse is the first major milestone opening for the Delta Sky Way program that will also feature a new concourse for Terminal 3 and a post-security connection between Terminal 3 and Tom Bradley International Terminal



Seven security screening lanes will be open in April, and by summer all 14 will be open, 11 of which are Automated Screening Lanes



3. REMINDER: Terminal 5.5 Pedestrian Bridge


• The APM project will construct a Pedestrian Bridge over the roadways between Terminals 5 and 6 to connect the APM's Center CTA Station with the Terminal 5.5 Vertical Core

Arrivals Level Impacts


- Overnight (10PM to 7AM) full closures of Arrivals Level Outer Lanes are scheduled through Wednesday, April 27 (no weekend work Friday nights through Sunday mornings) and overnight Monday, May 23 to Tuesday, May 24
- During overnight outer lane closures, all traffic will be detoured to the Inner Lanes
- The long crosswalk between Terminal 6 and Parking Structure 6 will be closed 24/7 for the duration of this work; Signage and flaggers will be in place to assist with wayfinding

T6/7 Rental Car Shuttle Impacts

• During construction, the Terminal 6 / 7 Rental Car Shuttle Stop will be temporarily relocated to the Inner Lanes between Columns 6J and 7A (nightly only, between 10PM and 7AM)

Departures Level Impacts

- Overnight (12AM to 4PM) full closures of the Departures Level roadway at Terminal 5.5 are scheduled for Tuesday, April 19 through Wednesday, April 27 (no weekend work Friday nights through Sunday mornings)
- Traffic will be detoured per the illustration below

T5/6 Hotel & Private Parking Shuttle Impacts

- The Hotel & Private Parking Stops at Terminals 5 and 6 will both be closed during Departures Level full closures
- Guests will be directed to the stops at Terminal 4.5 or Terminal 7 (T7 stop not pictured on map); Signage and flaggers will be in place to assist with wayfinding
