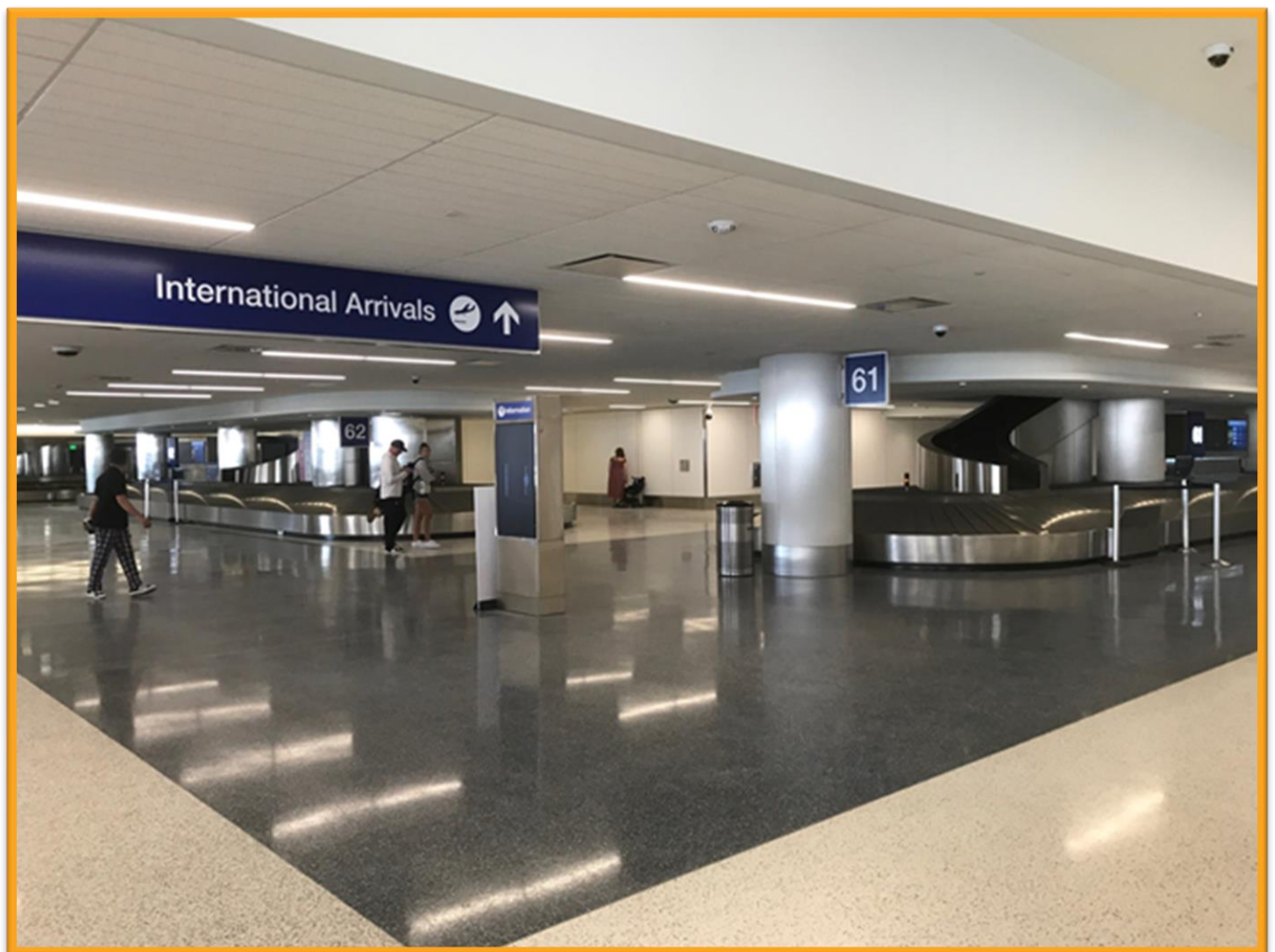

1. Terminal 6 Extension: New Baggage Claim Carousels and Restrooms

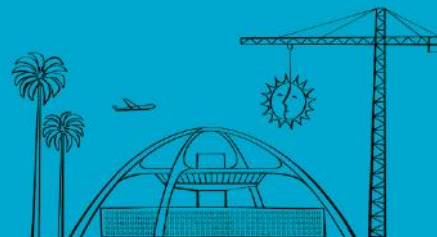
- With the opening of the new Terminal 6 Extension (between Terminals 5 and 6) the Arrivals Level has two additional baggage claim carousels
- This area can be reached via the passenger tunnel from the concourse, which has been closed for a portion of construction; some gates in the concourse remain closed while additional construction takes place
- On the Departures Level, new restrooms are now open in the Terminal 6 Extension building
- Upon the opening of the Automated People Mover, the Terminal 6 Extension will feature a pedestrian bridge that will connect the terminals with the APM's Center Station

2. Terminal 3: Construction Progress

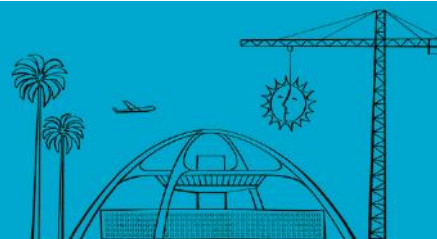
- Construction continues on the Terminal 3 Satellite and connector building to Terminal B, pictured below
- Due to construction, inner roadway lanes on both levels are restricted to provide a temporary pedestrian walkway around heavy construction
- Three gates in Terminal 3 opened earlier this year, with the remainder of gates under construction scheduled to reopen later this year

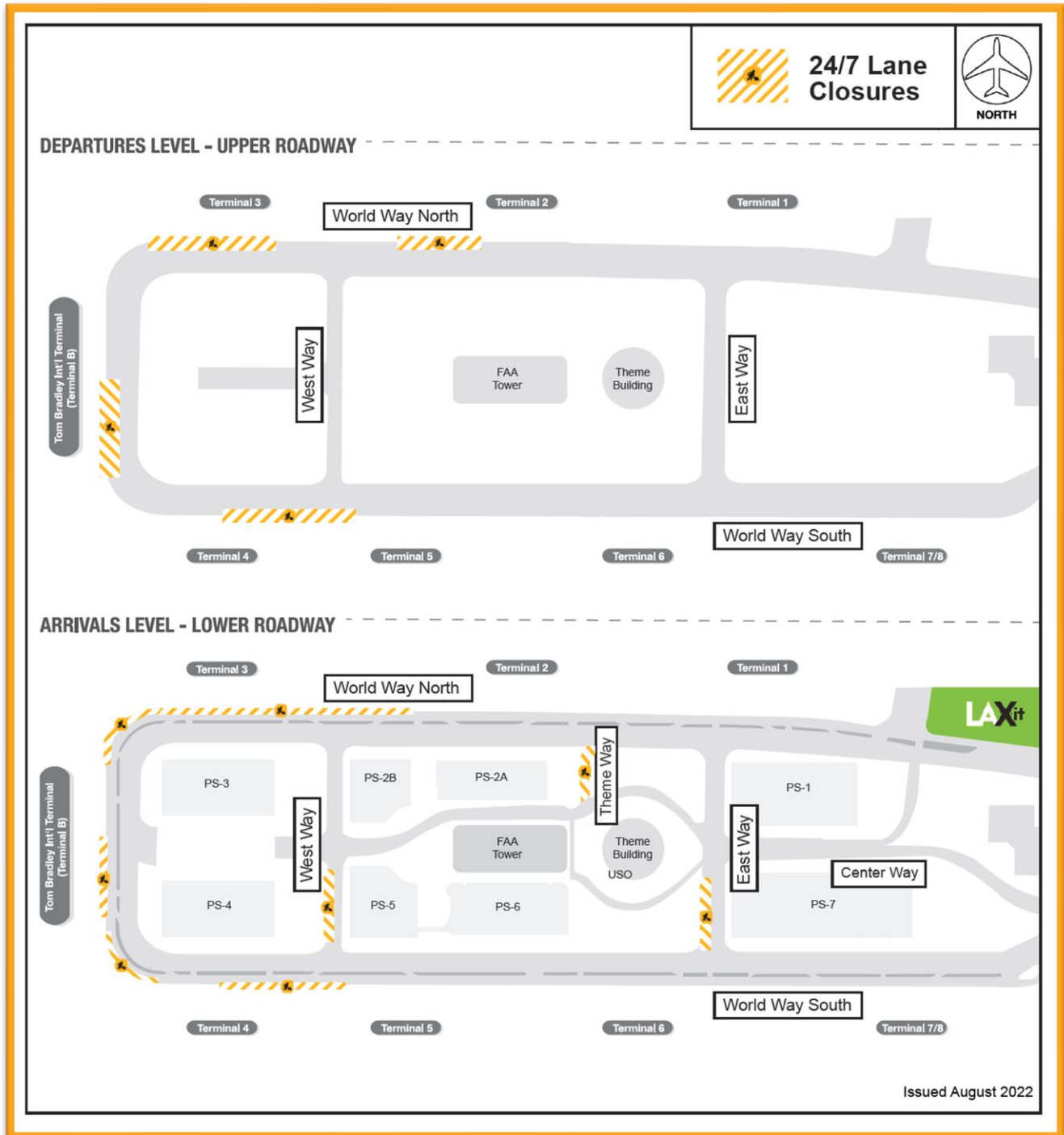
