1. LAX CTA Holiday Construction Moratorium

- The LAX Christmas & New Year's Holiday Moratorium is currently in effect through Tuesday, January 3, 2023
- Construction activity will be limited during this time to alleviate potential impacts to guests during the busy travel season

2. City of Los Angeles Public Streets Holiday Construction Moratoriums

 In addition to LAX's CTA Holiday Construction Moratorium, the City of Los Angeles is implementing holiday season public street closure restrictions now through December 25, 2022

3. Thanksgiving Week Holiday Travel

- With more than 200,000 passengers projected per day between December 16 and January 3, guests are encouraged to plan ahead to ensure a smooth airport experience
- Traffic around the Central Terminal Area is expected to surge with as many as 89,000 vehicles a day from between December 19 – 21, a 12% increase compared to the current daily average
- The aforementioned construction moratoriums have been implemented to lessen construction impacts to guests during this busier travel season impactful areas will be allowed
- LAX Parking Garages have seen historic use this year; guests are encouraged to pre-book a spot using
 <u>Parking.FlyLAX.com</u>, utilize the <u>LAX</u>
 <u>Economy Parking Facility</u> and free terminal shuttle, or use alternate options such as the <u>LAX FlyAway</u> service



- 4. Vicksburg Avenue Closure: Impacts to POV, Taxi and TNC Routes
 - To facilitate utility relocations for the Landside Access Modernization Program, Vicksburg Avenue between 96th & 98th Streets continues to undergo nightly closures through Saturday, January 28, 2023
 - Closures start at 11PM with the roadway re-opened by 7AM
 - Traffic will be maintained at all times via detours:
 - POVs maintained via Airport Blvd via 96th St or 98th St
 - Taxis maintained via 98th St to northbound Airport Blvd to westbound 96th St
 - TNCs maintained via northbound Jetway Blvd to westbound Westchester Pkwy to southbound Sepulveda Blvd



Detours are in place to maintain traffic during nightly closures of Vicksburg Ave between 96th & 98th Streets


