



- 1. Terminal 6: Airline Gate Re-Openings
  - In Terminal 6, Airline Gate 66 is scheduled to re-open this week on February 15 and Airline Gate 68A is scheduled to reopen on February 17
  - Both gates have been closed since March 2021

#### 2. Terminal 2 / 3: Project Update

- Construction continues on the Delta Sky Way Program to modernize Terminals 2 and 3
- Part of the project includes building a secure connection between Terminal 3 and Tom Bradley International Terminal, pictured below, which will allow passengers to move between the two terminals without leaving and having to be re-screened by TSA
- On the roadways, portions of both Departures and Arrivals Level lanes and sidewalks are closed to facilitate construction in front of Terminals 2 and 3; guests should watch for posted wayfinding and detour signage to safely navigate around restricted areas



When the Terminal 3 / Terminal B connection is complete, passengers will be able to walk between all LAX terminals without leaving security

#### 3. Phase 2: Sepulveda Tunnel Fire Detection Upgrade Project

- To facilitate the City of Los Angeles Bureau of Street Services' Fire Detection Upgrade Project, the Sepulveda Tunnel will experience lane restrictions through February 26, nightly from 11PM to 5AM
- This week, the project moves to Phase 2: Inside Lanes (2/13 – 2/20) which will close the inner two lanes both north- and southbound; one lane of traffic will be maintained at all times
- Next week (2/20 2/26) will see the final inspection to complete the project (and contingency dates for any delays)






This week, the inner two north- and southbound lanes in the Sepulveda Tunnel will be closed nightly from 11PM to 5AM
