The ever popular Basic Introduction to American Sign Language (ASL) Signing is coming to LAX on Wednesday, 30 October 2019.

0830 – 1230. BASIC SIGNING FOR AN AIRPORT ENVIRONMENT

Basic ASL is designed to assist personnel in opening dialog with deaf individuals and persons having difficulty communicating in English. The class will provide students a basic understanding of ways to communicate with deaf and hard of hearing individuals; persons with cognitive issues, and others who may have trouble communicating with you. The class will also address the consequences of assuming a deaf person can hear simply because "they don't look disabled".

Special attention will be given to communicating with deaf and hard of hearing persons during disasters and similar emergencies; in addition interaction techniques for law enforcement will be discussed and demonstrated.

<u>Who should attend:</u> Airport community members wanting to know how to interact with deaf and hard of hearing travelers, airport police, traffic officers, TSA; FIS Personnel and anyone dealing with the public will benefit from taking this class. The class is also recommended for anyone assisting people during disasters or evacuations. People who have previously taken Basic Signing can take the class as a refresher course.


