1. Automated People Mover: Project Update

- Construction continues on the Automated People Mover Project at LAX; upon completion it is anticipated to move more than 30 million passengers a year, eliminating an estimated 117,000 vehicle miles traveled per day
- The track at the APM's Maintenance & Storage Facility, located east of Airport Boulevard between Arbor Vitae Street and 96th Street, has been fully electrified
- Work will continue to electrify the track on the guideway, after which the first tests of the APM can begin
- The ninth and tenth APM train cars were delivered to LAX earlier this month; there will be a total of 44 train cars, each with the capacity to hold 50 passengers with luggage

2. POSTPONED: Sepulveda Tunnel Fire Detection Upgrade Project

- The City of Los Angeles Bureau of Street Services' Fire Detection Upgrade Project, which was scheduled to begin this week, has been postponed to early February 2023
- Work will close either the inner two lanes or outer two lanes on each side of the Tunnel between 11PM and 5AM
- One lane of through traffic in both directions will be maintained at all times
