## **Construction Hot Topics**

## 1. Terminal 2: Departures Level, Elevator T2-01

 There will be floor tile repair in the vestibule of Elevator T2-01 in Terminal 2's Departures area (pre-security). The work will take place from 9pm – 6am beginning tonight, June 5 through Friday, June 9. As a result, the elevator will be closed during these times. Signage will be in place indicating it is closed and directing passengers to alternate vertical transportation. Directly across from Elevator T2-01 is Elevator T2-02 which will be operational.



2. Parking Structure 3: Lower Level Sidewalk

- All of the sidewalks at Parking Structure 3 are open! The barricades along Parking Structure 3's Northwest and West vestibules have been removed. This results in unobstructed access to the sidewalk and crosswalks along the entire North and West sides of PS-3 (both images below), which improves overall access for guests using this structure.
- There are a few remaining panels that need to be affixed to the exterior of the structure. This work will be intermittent and may result in short-term lane restrictions and/or barricading as needed.





- 3. Terminal 7: Airside, Gate 74
  - Gate 74 closed at the end of March to undergo upgrades for the United Redevelopment program. The work is scheduled to complete at the end of this week. Current activity includes the installation of the new passenger boarding bridge (PBB). Pieces were lifted into place this morning by crane.



- 4. Terminal 1: Airside, Busing Operations
  - In tandem with last month's Airline Move, Southwest's international operations changed from Terminal 2 to Terminal B. Among several other airline split operations, this is an example of check-in occurring at one terminal and departures/arrivals happening at another. For Terminal 1 passengers who are flying internationally, check-in occurs at Terminal 1, followed by busing to Terminal B. The bus is fully operational adjacent to Gate 12 (both images below).
