1. Terminal 8: Concourse

 As part of the United Redevelopment program, Gates 85 – 87 are being renovated, from the interior/concourse side, as well as the exterior/apron side. Renovation will be ongoing through April. Closure of the gates will be phased, with Gate 87 closing at the end of December; Gate 86 closing at the beginning of January; and Gate 85 closing at the end of January.



2. Arrivals: Service Road

• Roadway improvements are underway along the CTA's southeast service road, adjacent to Terminal 8. The roadway is being widened and the sidewalk repoured. This will improve traffic flow and reduce congestion. Activity has gone quickly, and the asphalt was laid last night, making it possible that demobilization will occur prior to the current completion date of the end of January.



3. Airside and Public Streets: Dirt Hauling

- With several projects well underway on the AOA, construction efforts either require the removal of dirt or the addition of dirt. Between the Midfield Satellite Concourse (MSC) project's several components, Gateway and Crossover sites, and the Delta WAMA site, there is heavy dirt hauling from the Airside to public access streets. These streets include World Way West, Pershing Drive, and Westchester Parkway.
- Hauling is ongoing through February, with some circuits being completed during the day (9AM 4:30PM) and some during the night (10PM – 6AM). Special notices have been issued for these assorted hauling activities to keep the airport community aware of impacts to these commonly traveled areas.
