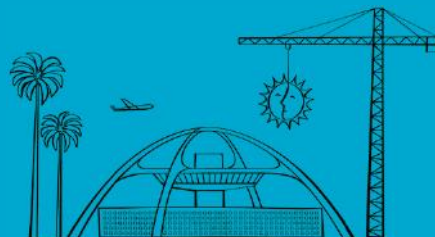
2. Terminal B: New Concession Now Open

- Alfred is now open in the Terminal 3 concourse, serving coffee, new food items and more; the concession is open at 4:30AM daily

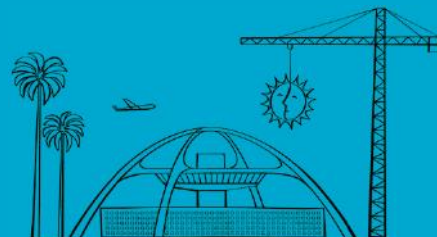


4. City of Los Angeles Public Streets Holiday Construction Moratoriums

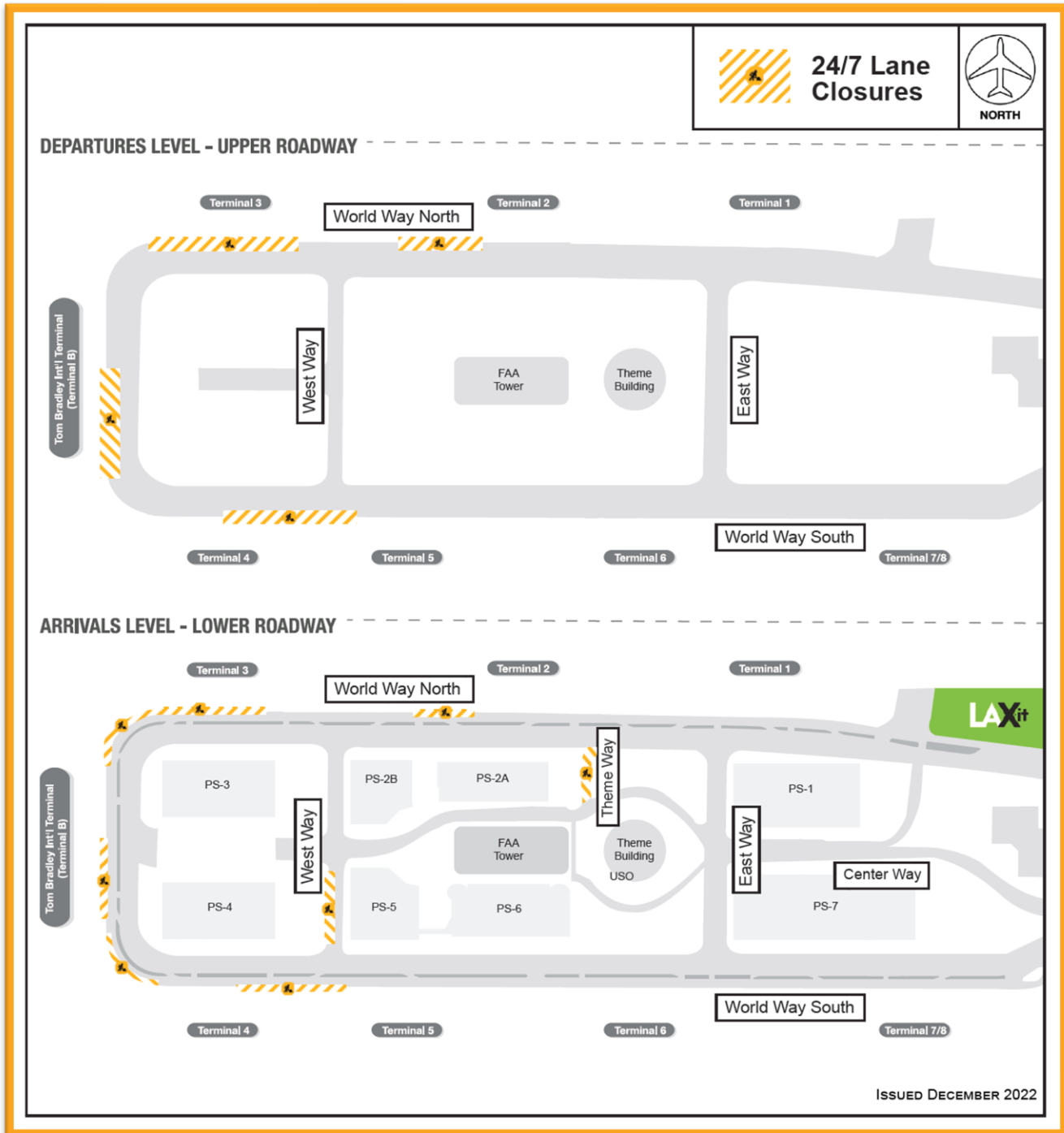
