Program Updates

CONRAC

- LAWA staff and consultants have narrowed CONRAC to three concepts.
- For purposes of environmental analysis, concepts are substantially similar.
- LAWA staff, in consultation with the rental car companies, will continue working to select a single CONRAC concept to move into design.

96th Street Metro Transit Station

- Metro selection of locally preferred alternative requires additional APM station.
- Staff recommends creation of adjacent commercial transit center, along with pick-up, drop-off, and parking facilities.
- LAWA continues to collaborate with Metro on station design and delivery strategies.



APM Alignment

- In the CTA, staff recommended alignment remains "Three Station Spine" Concept.
- East of Sepulveda, staff recommended alignment remains essentially unchanged.
- East of Airport Boulevard, staff recommends the "96th Street Alignment" in response to discussions with stakeholders and in an effort to improve APM design.
