#### LAX Modernization



- LAMP will
  - Relieve traffic congestion within the CTA and the surrounding street network;
  - Create new convenient locations for passenger pick-up/drop-off and parking outside of the CTA;
  - Give passengers a fast and reliable way to get to their flights; and
  - Reduce vehicle emissions and improve air quality.
