The \$1.545-billion Bradley West Project has broken ground. The project will create a new world-class terminal, featuring 15 new boarding gates to accommodate New Large Aircraft, enlarged passenger seating/holdroom areas, food/beverage and retail concessions, new premium lounge space, and enlarged Federal Inspection/Customs and Border Protection facilities, among other amenities.
