

AIRLINE RELOCATIONS AT LAX

Two airlines currently operating at Terminal 6 will relocate operations to Terminal 3 in May.

Allegiant Airlines will cease operations at Terminal 6 on the night of April 30, 2013 and commence operating from Terminal 3 on Wednesday, May 1, 2013. Allegiant Airlines operates MD 80 aircraft to/from LAX and offers about 12 flights per week.

A week later, Frontier Airlines will cease operations at Terminal 6 and commence operations at Terminal 3 on Wednesday May 8, 2013. Frontier Airlines operates A319 and A320 aircraft to/from LAX and offers about 27 flights per week.

Allegiant Airlines and Frontier Airlines join JetBlue Airlines, Spirit Airlines, Virgin America, and Virgin Australia at Terminal 3.
