

TBIT CROSSWALK CLOSURE

On Monday, 4th of March, 2013 the crosswalk between TBIT and parking structure 3 on the lower level road way will be closed for a period of 10 days. Since the south crosswalk between TBIT and parking structure 4 is already closed, the additional closure will require passengers and stakeholders to use the north crosswalk (between Terminal 3 and parking structure 3) or the south crosswalk (between Terminal 4 and parking structure 4). Crosswalk access from TBIT to parking structure 3 on the upper level roadway will remain open throughout this period.

During the crosswalk closure, the west side elevator lobby in parking structure 3 will also undergo refurbishment and hence will not be accessible from Level 1 and Level 3 of the structure. Passengers and stakeholders may use the stairwell or the alternate north elevator in the parking structure.

Appropriate signs will be in place to assist way finding during the closure. In addition, LAWA Customer Service Representatives and Traffic Officers will be positioned in front of TBIT entrances, both on the lower and upper levels to assist during peak hours of passenger and vehicular traffic movement.
