

THREE SEPARATE TRAFFIC ADVISORIES AFFECTING CENTURY BOULEVARD BEGINNING JULY 26^{TH} THROUGH AUGUST 27^{TH}

1 of 3 Advisory:

From Tuesday, July 26th to Friday, 29th from 11pm to 6am nightly, Metro will restrict the curb-lane on eastbound Century Boulevard before Aviation Boulevard. The remaining eastbound lanes will be open and the right turn pocket to southbound Aviation Boulevard will also be maintained.

2 of 3 Advisory:

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close the southbound I-405 (westbound) Century Boulevard on- and off-ramps at La Cienega Boulevard for <u>55-hours</u>, starting at 10 p.m. Friday, July 29 to 5 a.m. Monday, August 1. La Cienega Boulevard on- and off-ramps will remain open. A signed detour will be posted.

3 of 3 Advisory:

From Monday, August 1st to August 27th, Century Boulevard will be closed between Aviation Boulevard and La Cienega Boulevard for the Metro Crenshaw/LAX Transit Project. This work will require full closure of either westbound or eastbound lanes but not both at the same time. The closure will be from 11pm to 6am on weeknights only. All lanes will be reopened after this timeframe and throughout the weekend. The detour route will be through Arbor Vitae Street and Airport Boulevard then back to Century Boulevard.

LAWA Media Public Relations, in collaboration with Metro and Caltrans, will launch an outreach effort to inform the traveling public and the airport community. Please share this advisory with your respective passengers, employees, and others who are not on the distribution list. All passengers, employees, and service providers are encouraged to allow extra time to travel to and from LAX.
