
# **New Face of TBIT**

In conjunction with the Gala Event for the Bradley West facility, the New Face of TBIT project was completed last month. The key elements included:

- → Landscaping & Other Aesthetic Improvements
- → New Light Poles
- → New Electronic Light Band


These new light poles and color electronic graphics will eventually circle the upper level roadway and fascia of the entire Central Terminal Area, providing much needed improved lighting on the roadways. The color light features reflect and work with the LAX entry light columns.





# South Concourse CUTE Testing

Common Use Terminal Equipment (CUTE) testing at July each new gate in the South Concourse of the Bradley West facility. LAWA and SITA have confirmed that been commissioned and are ready for the TBIT airlines to conduct testing. In order to conduct the testing efficiently the contractor and SITA have confirmed the necessary manpower to support the required testing for all TBIT airlines over a **two week period from 15-26 July 2013**. CUTE testing for these five new gates will take approximately 2 hours per airline and SITA will be 0700-1700 each week.



Successful completion of CUTE testing at each gate is necessary to prepare the TBIT airlines for operations in both the new Central Core and South Concourse gates. LAWA Operations will not assign an airline to a new available to support your schedule Monday-Friday from Bradley West gate until this CUTE testing is complete and confirmed by SITA.

# **Eighteen Operating**

Four more TBIT airlines, Thai Airways (TG), Asiana cility on the 6th of June and EK brought the total to Airlines (OZ), All Nippon Airways (NH) and Emirates eighteen with their B777-300 operation at Gate 130 on Airline (EK), began operations at the new Bradley West June 18th.
