

## **UNITED AIRLINES (UAL) EAST AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE AND GROUND SUPPORT EQUIPMENT (GSE) PROJECT**

### **WHAT IS THE UAL EAST AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE AND GSE PROJECT?**

The United Airlines East Aircraft Maintenance and GSE Project would consolidate and modernize UAL's existing aircraft and GSE maintenance facilities at LAX in a single location to provide for more efficient and effective maintenance of UAL aircraft and equipment at the airport that eliminates duplicate facilities. Currently, UAL performs maintenance in two areas of LAX, known as the West Maintenance Facility and the East Maintenance Facility.

### **WHERE WOULD THE PROJECT BE LOCATED?**


The consolidated East Aircraft Maintenance and GSE Facility would be located on UAL's leasehold, south of Century Boulevard and east of Avion Drive.

### **STATE OF THE ART FACILITY**

The proposed project would be designed and constructed to achieve the United States Green Building Council's Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED®) Silver certification, which requires the project to be designed in a manner to save energy, water and other resources. In addition, the proposed project would be constructed in accordance with the Los Angeles Green Building Code, including its energy conservation requirements. The proposed project also incorporates other modern components, such as charging stations for electric GSE.


### **ESTIMATED SCHEDULE**

This project requires both local and federal approval, including environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act and the National Environmental Policy Act.



## KEY PROJECT CHARACTERISTICS

- Demolish some of the existing buildings
- Construct the new maintenance facility
- Reconfigure aircraft parking
- Provide an aircraft wash pad
- Construct a jet blast deflector (safety barrier that is used to substantially reduce or eliminate the effects of jet blast or propeller wash from run-up areas)
