#### 1. ADDITIONAL WORKDAY NEEDED: Northbound Sepulveda Boulevard Impacts

- To facilitate wayfinding installation for the Landside Access Modernization Program, northbound Sepulveda Boulevard between Imperial Highway and Century Boulevard, including the westbound I-105 Freeway offramp at Sepulveda Boulevard, is scheduled to be closed again this upcoming Sunday, April 23 from 12AM to 4AM
- This same closure was performed last Sunday, April 16; another four hour closure is needed to complete the work
- Southbound Sepulveda Boulevard is not impacted by this work
- Vehicles will be detoured via westbound Imperial Highway to northbound Pershing Drive to eastbound Westchester Parkway

- 3. Consolidated Rent-A-Car Facility Recognized with Green Bond of the Year Award
  - LAWA's Consolidated Rent-A-Car (ConRAC) Facility, one of the major components of LAX's \$5.5 billion Landside Access Modernization Program (LAMP), was recently recognized by Environmental Finance as the 2023 Green Bond of the Year award recipient
  - The award acknowledges the successful effort to raise financing for the construction of ConRAC with green bonds, showcasing a commitment to decarbonizing transportation and achieving carbon neutrality by 2045
  - This is the first time an airport has achieved this distinction
  - Scheduled to open in 2023, the ConRAC Facility will consolidate rental car operations currently spread across the surrounding area of LAX into one location conveniently located adjacent to the 405 freeway
  - Sustainable design has been at the forefront of the ConRAC Facility, including elements such as native drought-tolerant landscaping, reclaimed water usage and a solar farm generating approximately 8,400 megawatt hours annually
